EXAM PREPARATION CLASSES

➤ FIRST CERTIFICATE IN ENGLISH

(FCE - Cambridge Level 3 - B2 Common European Framework)

➤ CERTIFICATE IN ADVANCED ENGLISH

(CAE - Cambridge Level 4 - C1 Common European Framework); This exam is recognised by the majority of British universities as fulfilling entrance requirements in English language.

➤ CERTIFICATE OF PROFICIENCY IN ENGLISH

(CPE - Cambridge Level 5 - C2 Common European Framework); This exam is recognised as fulfilling English language entry requirements in English language by British universities and universities in other English-speaking countries.

➤ INTERNATIONAL ENGLISH LANGUAGE TESTING SYSTEM

IELTS: exam is taken by students wishing to go to university. Universities usually request a score of **6.5 to 7.5 (B2 - C2)** as a minimum entry requirement.

Student Life and Social Programme

The College organises regular trips to places of interest in London. Students are accompanied by a member of staff and it is a good opportunity to meet other students and practise speaking English. We also hold parties at the end of every term.

During the summer students can visit places outside London such as Brighton, Cambridge and Oxford.

Enrolment

You may enrol in person any weekday (excluding weekends and bank holidays), during office hours. You may also enrol by phone, email or post. A college certificate is awarded to every student who successfully completes a course of study.

Juniors and Groups: We accept junior groups of under 16s at Golders Green College throughout the year.

16-18 Year Olds: Most students on our English courses are over 18 years old however, we do accept students aged 16-17. Please contact us for more details.

Student Visas

Students come from many countries.

You may need to apply for a visa. Make sure you give full details of why you want to study.

You need a detailed study plan and you will need to supply detailed financial information.

Our daytime classes (15 hours per week) qualify as full-time courses of study in the UK.

The certificate of enrolment, required for visa applications, is issued by the College on full payment of fees. We work with licensed immigration advisers in order to improve your chances of getting a visa.
